In addition, JEBF strengthens youth work readiness through VT Goes to School, a vocational training initiative delivered directly in schools as an intervention to bridge the gap between industry needs and formal education.

The program consists of two main components: JADIPro Curriculum Training, which equips students with 4C soft skills, digital tools competencies, and job readiness fundamentals; and Work Readiness Training, which focuses on career preparation through CV and cover letter writing, interview skills, and personal branding.

Our flagship program takes a dual approach:

Empowering mothers through microfinance while supporting their children's education through scholarships. This strategy aims to break the cycle of poverty by equipping families for generational change. By linking access to loans with school enrollment and improving daily income, the program creates a clear pathway out of poverty and into the aspiring middle class.
